What Is The Cost?

The weekend costs \$315 per couple. This includes your housing and meals.

How To Register:

First call or email the registration couple listed on the front of this brochure to assure space on the weekend you prefer. Then, print out and fill out your

Write your check or money order for \$315 payable to Catholic Engaged Encounter.

Mail it and your Registration form to couple listed on this brochure and our website.

Registration deadline is 14 days prior to the scheduled weekend. We are often booked well ahead, and space is limited. So please register early with included full fee enclosed to assure your space on the selected weekend.



What If We Need to Reschedule or Cancel?

If you can't make your scheduled weekend, we encourage you to reschedule.

Rescheduling

There is no additional cost if you reschedule at least 8 days prior to your weekend. Otherwise, there is a \$75 fee.

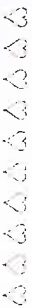
Cancelling

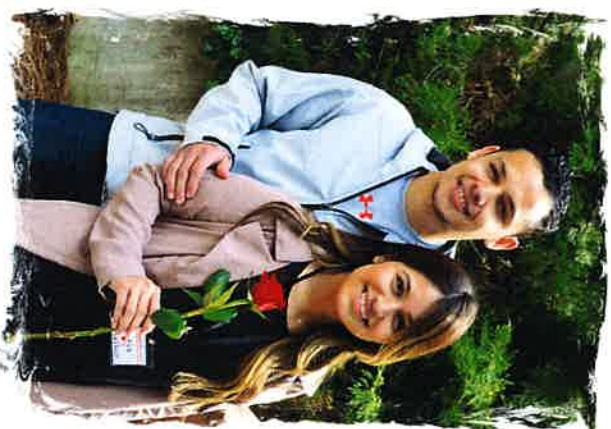
